#### Curriculum

Vanshi Manthan Vidyashram is affiliated to Edexcel, UK for Primary and Secondary (upto Class XII).

The Programs offered include Pre-KG to IGCSE (Class X) and IAL (Class XI & XII ), Edexcel - LIK

Manthan has integrated the syllabi of CBSE, ICSE and Matriculation upto class VII to enable children move effortlessly from Manthan to any other school in the country, whenever the need for transfer arises. English is the medium of instruction. Manthan's panel of educationists constantly train its teachers in the latest and innovative teaching techniques which help the children to be creative and conceptually clear rather than memorize answers. The performance of Manthan children in ASSET (a national benchmark examination) is comparable to the top10 schools in the country. Std XII children secured admission in International, National and State Universities.

#### **Facilities**

**Pre-KG to Std V**: Classrooms are equipped with digital projectors with content from various sources. **Std VI to XII**: Classrooms are fitted with interactive digital board that facilitates learning with the help of sophisticated educational tools. Manthan library has close to 24000 books of which more than 6000 are story books catering to children from LKG to Std XII. This is to inculcate a sound reading habit among children.

#### **Emagazine**

The Emag publication initiated by Manthan is among the many activities aimed at empowering and honing the skills of our children. Combining several different forms of expression – articles, stories, puzzles, reports, photography, painting – the Emag has space for every child.

#### **Inter-House Competitions**

Inter-house competitions form an integral part of Manthan's curriculum. It provides a platform for each and every child to participate and display their talent in academics and extra-curricular activities.

These competitions help to bring out good co-ordination within the teams and build leadership qualities.

Manthan offers Cricket, Basket Ball, Shuttle Badminton and Volley Ball after class hours for a healthy balance of mind and body

#### Importance of Attendance

The child must attend at least 85% of working days for his / her promotion to the next class. Manthan focuses on child's healthy intellectual, emotional and overall personality development. This is directly dependent on the utilization of opportunities and exposure that can be availed through various activities, academic and non-academic. Hence regular attendance is essential to gain fruitful learning experience.

#### **Evaluation & Feedback Procedure**

Evaluation and Report card sessions are important as they give the status of the child's progress and what needs to be done further to ensure an improved academic performance and overall development of the child.

All classes have mid-semester evaluations in the months of July and December and Semester evaluations in September / October and February / March. Progress report for semester I will be given in the month of October / November and that of semester II by April. Manthan

expects parents to review the performance of their child with Manthan Teachers during report card sessions. Report card of Semester I must be returned within 2 days after duly signing it and Semester II report card may be retained.





# Closing of Academic Year

Manthan will close for summer on the last working day of April every year. Manthan requests all parents to plan their holidays after the completion of report card session.
